#### **Tools and materials:**


wooden frame app. 20X20 in, wooden stick app. 8-10 in long scissors, pencil, ruler, paper tape, cotton warp thread, wool and acrylic yarn for weft, fork, piece of cardboard app. 8-10 in long paper for the pattern.

#### Warping the frame.

- Step 1. Marking the frame
- Step 2. Warping the frame.
- Step 3. Putting cardboard between threads.
- Step 4. Making a chain.
- Step 5. Tying heddles (10 inches long, 18 pieces)
- Step 6. Inserting the ruler into the shed.



# Diagram of warping the loom








